Meeting Minutes

- The minutes of the last meeting were reviewed and approved
- Greg Mehlhop gave the Treasures Report – we have \$791 in checking and \$3,952 in savings

- Darryl Jarombek was voted in as the Lead for Water Testing. Charlie agreed to find out the dates for testing
- Loon Nest, Mark is still here for this summer to help with this, Bill Karsten has agreed to provide storage for the equipment when not in use.
- Lakeporte Township donated \$2,500 and Hart Lake Township donated \$1,250 for AIS inspection. The Hart Lake donation went to a vote and Mark Warisch and Greg Mehlhop's presence and

votes in favor helped secure the funds. Ron Ray will send thank you notes to the townships.

- Dan will follow up with the Mayor of Laporte to see if they contributed this year to AIS inspections.
- It was decided to have the annual meeting on 6/4/22. Dan will check with the Woodshed to see if their back room is available for the meeting.
